The Production Insurance program and your participation activities are still the same. As always, you can still select or make changes to your coverage every year.

Your contract

Same terms. Easier read.

We refreshed the *Contract of Insurance* for Production Insurance using plain language – it’s shorter and easier to read, allowing you to find what you are looking for more quickly. Understanding your contract is important because it protects your interests when you have a loss. The contract is Agricorp’s promise to pay when certain, defined events occur in the future.

While the terms and conditions have not changed, you’ll need less time to review your contract.

What does the refreshed contract mean for you?

- ▶ Easier to understand – uses clear language
- ▶ Faster to review – fewer pages
- ▶ Gives you more confidence to make decisions

Your Production Insurance contract is now made up of 3 parts:

- ▶ **General Terms**
The terms and conditions applicable to all commodities.
- ▶ **Commodity-Specific Terms**
The terms and conditions applicable to a specific commodity.
- ▶ **Coverage Confirmation**
Confirms final coverage of commodities insured, quantity, coverage level, premium, and other policy details. You receive a coverage confirmation after you report your insured quantities (e.g., final acres) and before you pay your premium.

You can report acres online for nearly 40 commodities, including the following newly added commodities:

- ▶ **Fresh vegetables** (average farm yield basis)
Onions (seed, set, Spanish), potatoes, rutabagas
- ▶ **Processing vegetables** (average farm yield basis)
Butternut squash, carrots, potatoes, rutabagas
- ▶ **Other commodities**
Black tobacco, flue-cured tobacco, hemp
