Fresh Vegetables (Acreage-Loss Basis)

The information in this document applies to crops in the fresh vegetable, acreage loss-plans. See the list of insurable crops below.

Updates

Making coverage changes – This year, you have until May 31, 2021, to make any changes to your coverage.

Coverage extended for on-farm labour disruptions due to COVID-19 – Coverage added in 2020 for production losses caused by on-farm labour disruptions due to COVID-19 is extended for the 2021 program year. For more information, visit agricorp.com.

Same insurance. New look. – We have refreshed the renewal notice and Contract of Insurance for Production Insurance. For more information, visit agricorp.com.

New name. Same coverage. – To align with other commodities insurable under Production Insurance, special protection coverage is now called “unseeded acreage coverage” and emergency measures is

now called “replant or salvage coverage.” For more information, visit agricorp.com.

Insurable value of your crops – In response to customer preference, one insurable value is available per commodity and class (instead of three options). Insurable values, abandonment thresholds and other important documents are available on agricorp.com.

Reporting your acres – You no longer need to submit an intended crop planting form and farm diagram, unless requested to do so under special circumstances. To reduce the amount of paperwork we send, you won't receive a final acreage report form in the mail anymore. To report your final acres, download the form and instructions at agricorp.com/acreage after May 1, 2021.

About premiums

Base premium rates for Production Insurance are set annually to reflect factors like past performance of the plan, changes to the claim price, and the level of the Ontario Agricultural Products Insurance Fund. The federal and provincial governments pay up to 60 per cent of the required premiums and 100 per cent of the administration cost of delivering the program.

Please refer to your renewal notice or invoice for premium rates specific to your individual coverage.

Calculating your premium

Premium = total insurable value × base premium rate

Total insurable value: Determined by multiplying the insurable value (for each crop) by the number of acres you plant.

Base premium rate: The base premium rate is determined at renewal time each year. It may change due to factors like past performance of the plans, changes to threshold levels and the level of the Ontario Agricultural Products Insurance Fund.
